Principal's Message

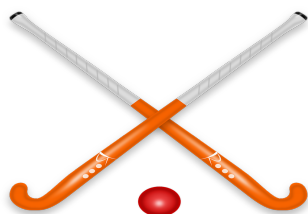


A reminder that school is closed on Monday, October 9th for the Columbus Day Holiday. Classes will resume on Tuesday, October 10th.

Band

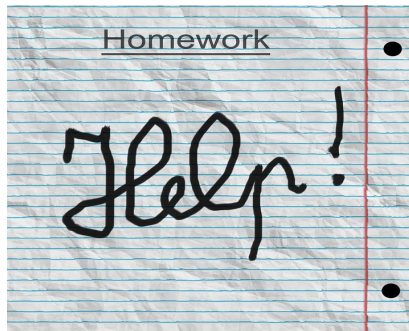
