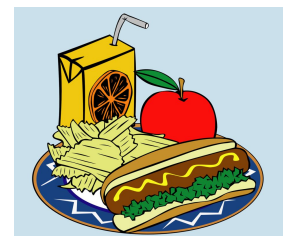
Free Summer Meals

Summer Care Program Registration Open

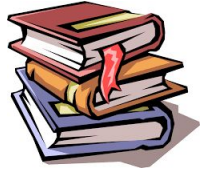

Sussex County Miners Read to Achieve Program

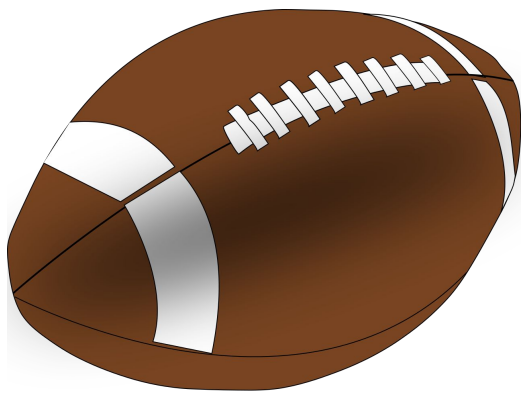
