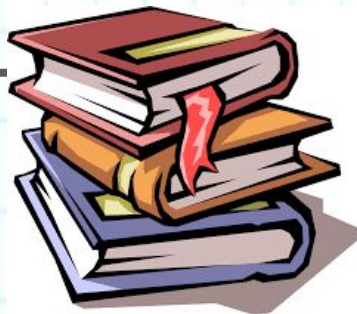

If your child is exhibiting any of the symptoms listed, click on the link that says [“Out Sick”](#) and complete the questionnaire and keep your child home.



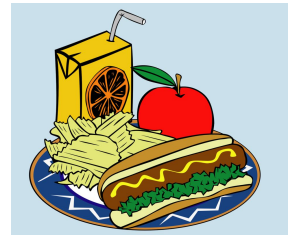

Summer Care Program Registration Open

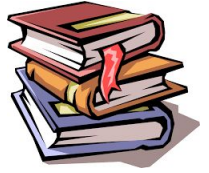
The Summer Care Program is offered from June 21st - August 14th from 7:00 am - 6:00 pm..

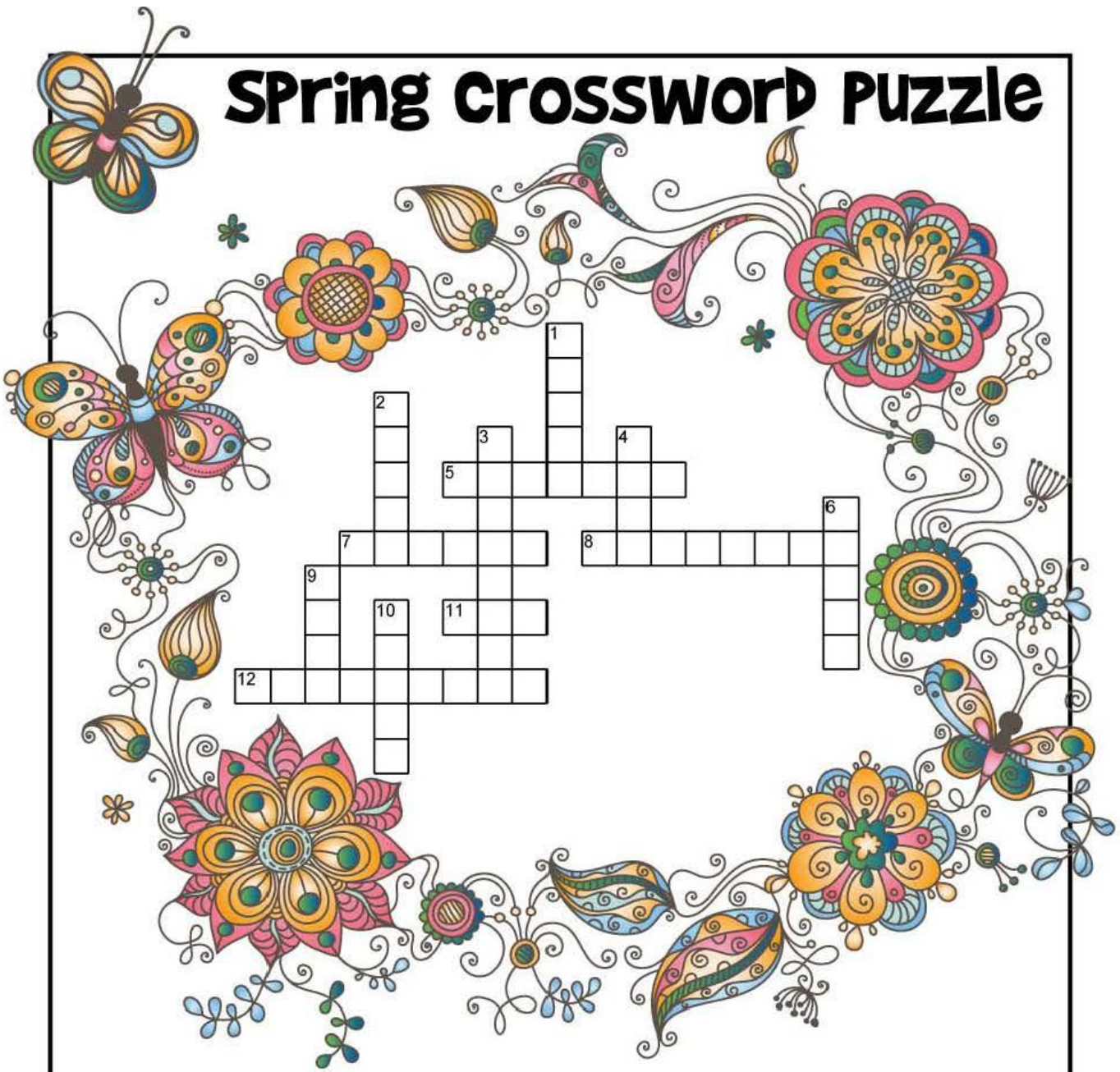
