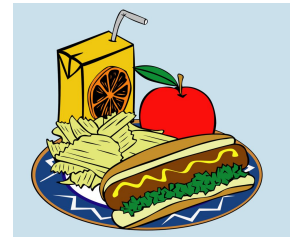

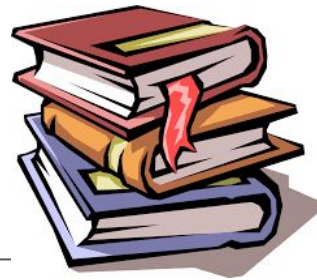
Scholastic is back with a SUMMER SEND OFF book fair!
