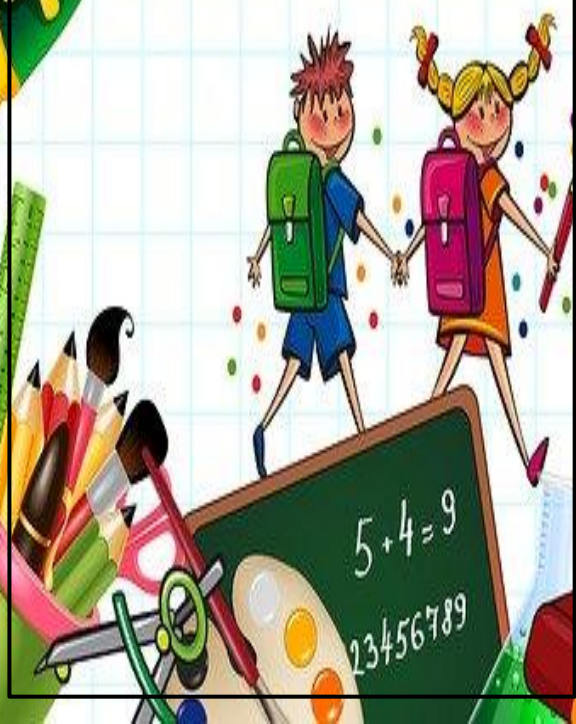

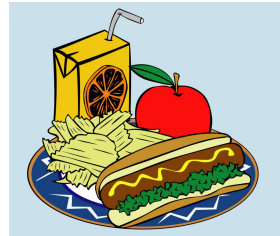
For fully virtual students, there is no food pickup during Spring Break week April 5th-9th.

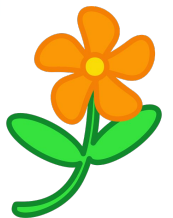
