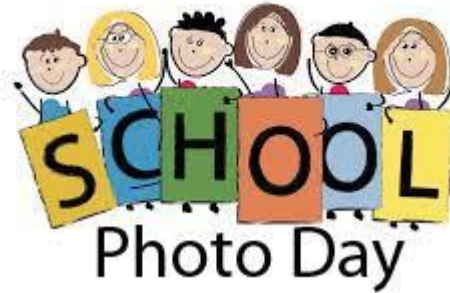

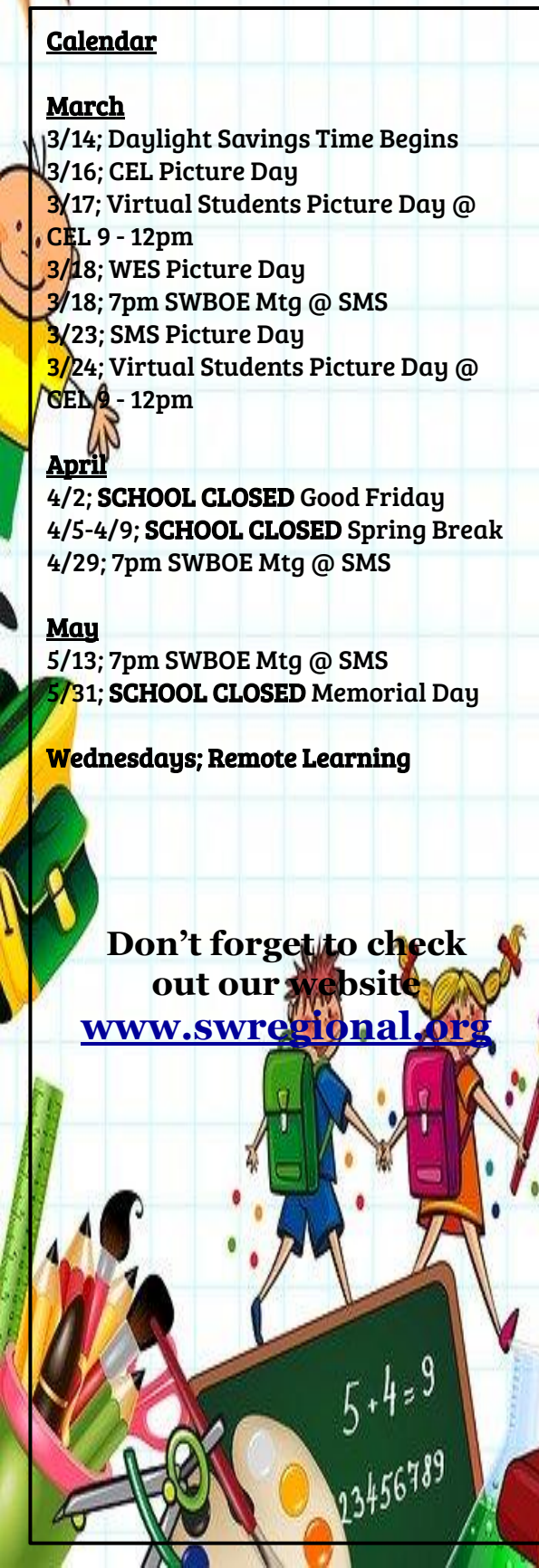

Free Meals

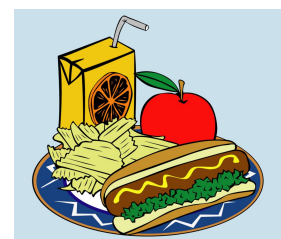
