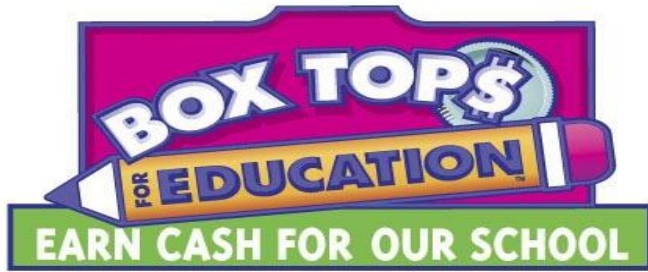

ing the week of December 16th-20th.

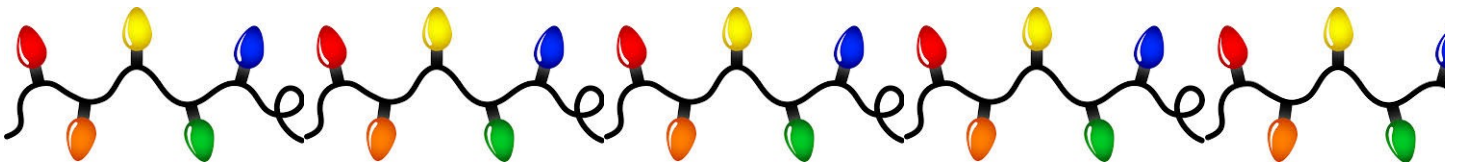
The winning district will take possession of the Stuff the Stocking trophy and re-

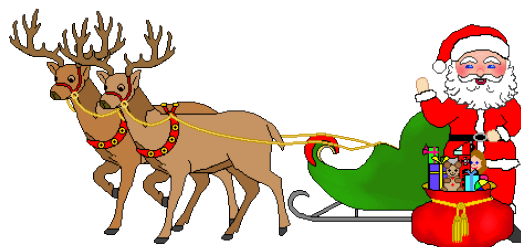
