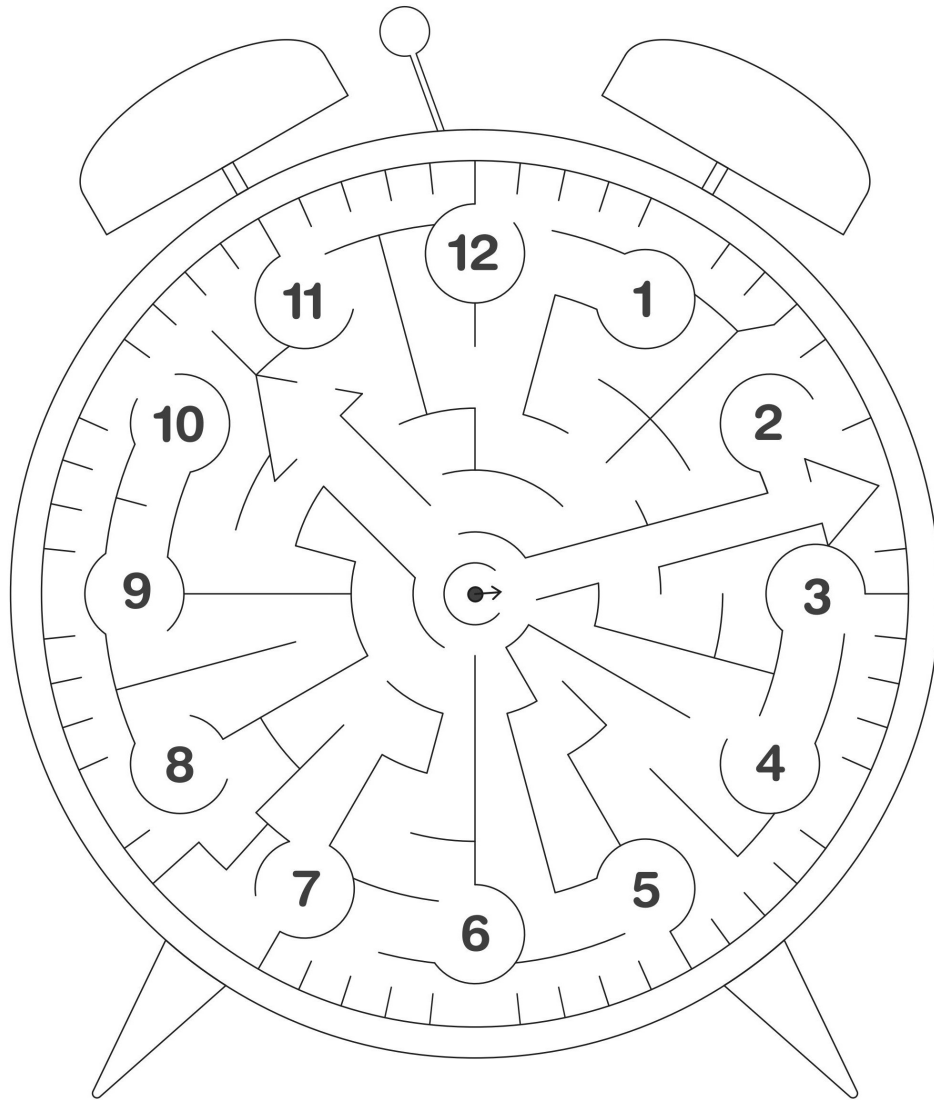

Start in the centre.

Find number 1 first and then visit each number around the clock dial in order (1,2,3,4 etc) without passing through any higher number first.

For example; After visiting number 3 you must pass through number 4 next. You must not pass through number 5 before visiting number 4! But it's ok to pass through again the same number you have just visited.
