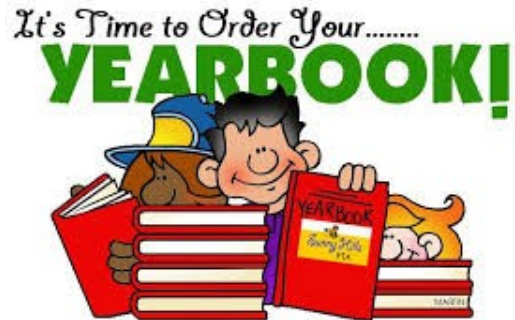

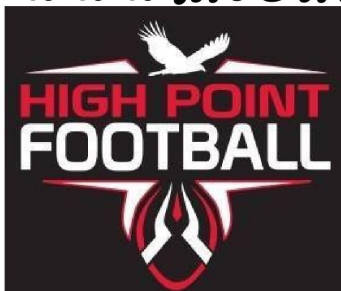

Together with their coaches, Heros from our local community help get the boys moving, motivated and in condition to finish a local 5k!

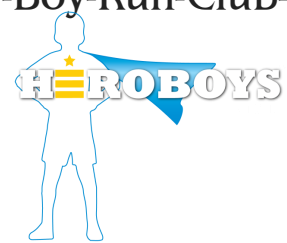







## Garden Tools




Fill in puzzle with garden tools.

**ACROSS**

1. Tool with rotating blades that churn soil
5. Tool used to create shape and remove excess
7. Long-handled gardening tool with thin metal blade used for tilling and raking
9. Notched screwdriver that penetrates deep into the soil to remove unwanted plants at their roots
11. Flexible pipe made of rubber or plastic that transfers water
13. Tool used to trim grass and weeds to define borders
14. Shovel-like tool with handle and flat, narrow blade for digging and planting
15. Device that scatters drops of water over an area of ground

2. Long-handled tool used for clearing leaves, grass clippings and debris
3. Building for plants that's made of glass or another transparent material
4. Tool with shovel-like blade used for spreading and dressing mortar in brickwork and walkways
6. Pronged tool used to break up dirt, spread compost and fertilizer, and remove weed roots
8. Long-handled digging tool with blade large enough to apply foot pressure if needed.
