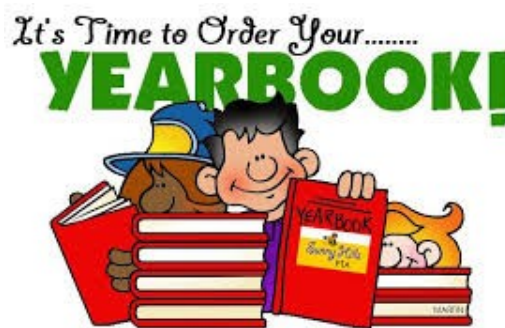

Together with their coaches, Heros from our local community help get the boys moving, motivated and in condition to finish a local 5k!

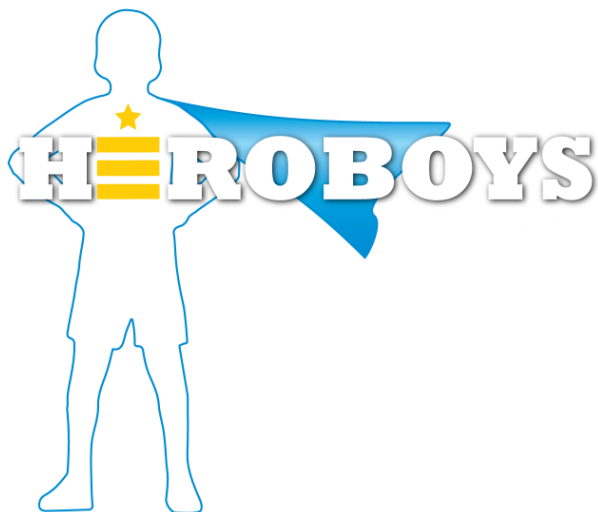
