Session 3- Bullying and the aftermath?

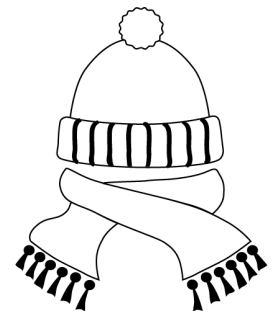
February 6, 2019 @ 6:30pm

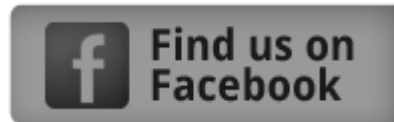

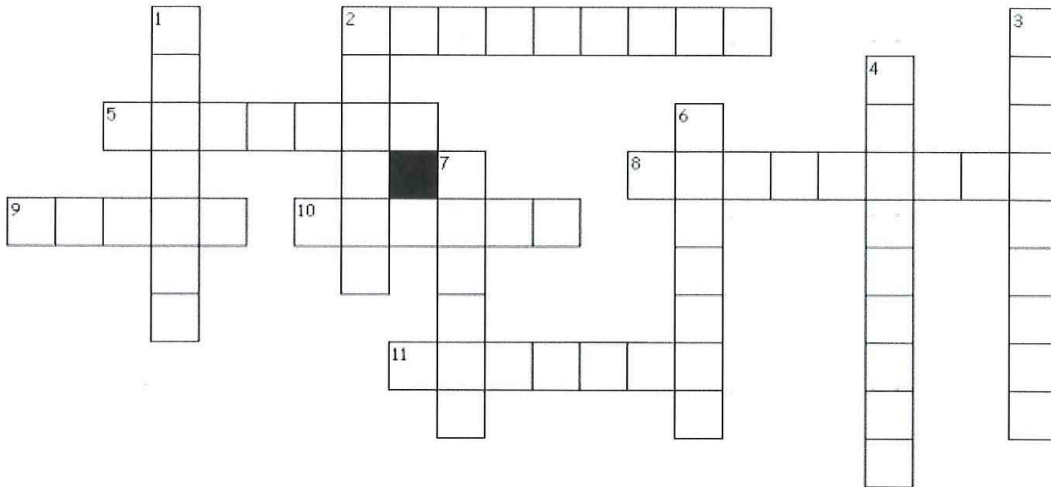

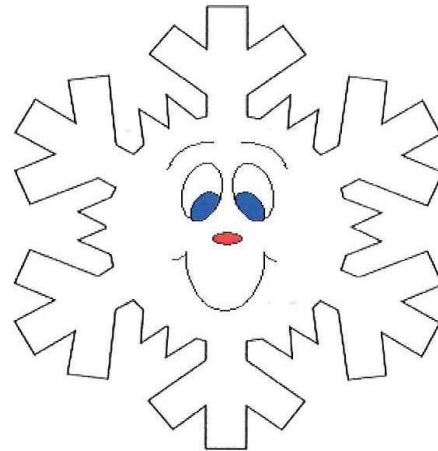


Winter Crossword



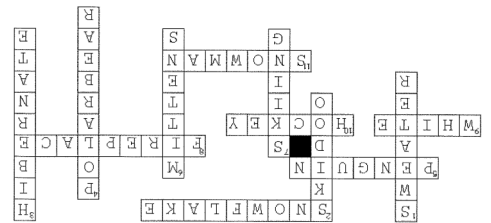
Across
