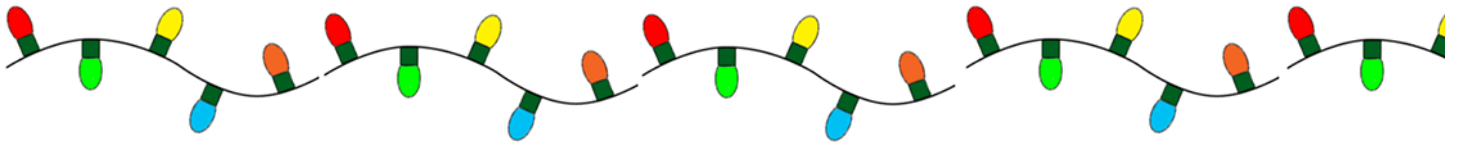
Single Candle Centerpiece

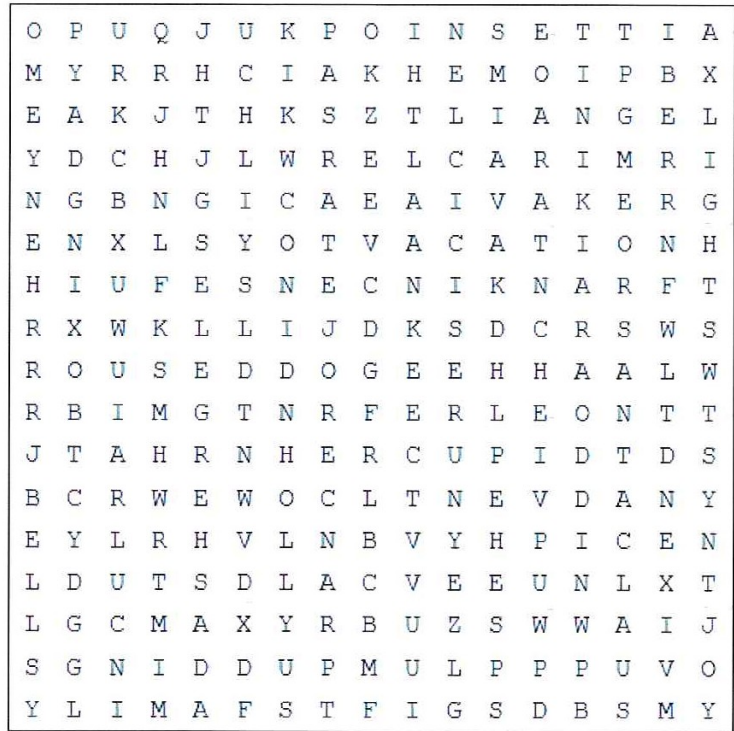
