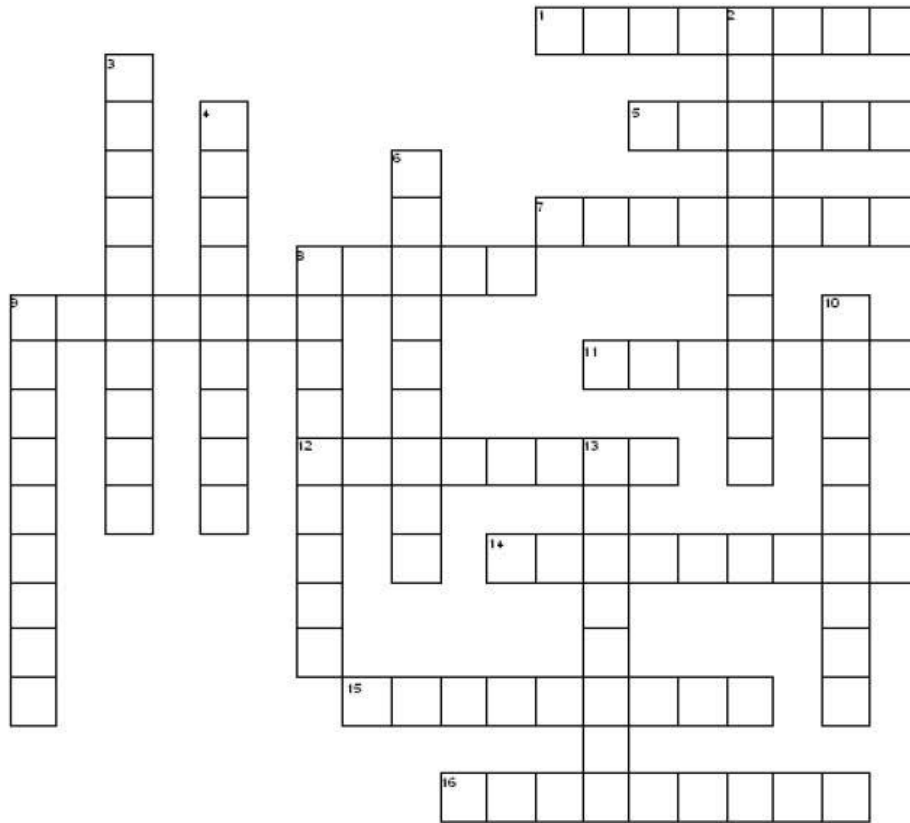
- Flag football is required for athletes entering kindergarten but is also open athletes in 1st and 2nd grades as well.
