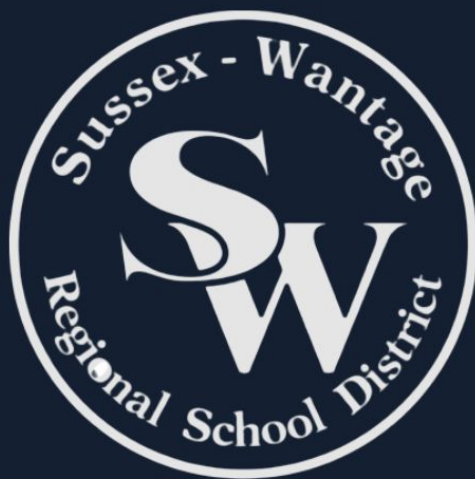

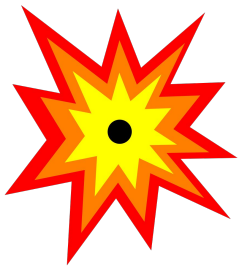

Solar Saturday, October 14 at 12:30 – 2:30 p.m.



Please join us to observe a partial solar eclipse. Twenty three percent of the sun will be obscured as the moon passes between the Earth and the Sun. Our volunteers will set up telescopes with special solar filters to safely view this rare event. This is something you don't want to miss!

FALL CONSTELLATIONS, STARS, AND SATURN

Friday, October 20 at 7:30pm--Rain/Cloud date: Saturday, October 21 at 7:30 pm

This is the last chance to observe the first quarter moon through our telescopes this year. Check out Saturn and its rings. As we say a final farewell to summer constellations, we can enjoy the many fall constellations as they make their way in the eastern sky.

Friday, November 3 at 7:00pm – Rain/Cloud date: Saturday, November 4 at 7:00 pm

This is our last astronomy event of the year. Besides Saturn, Jupiter will now be visible in the eastern sky and we will be able to observe the giant planet with its cloud belts and four of its moons.

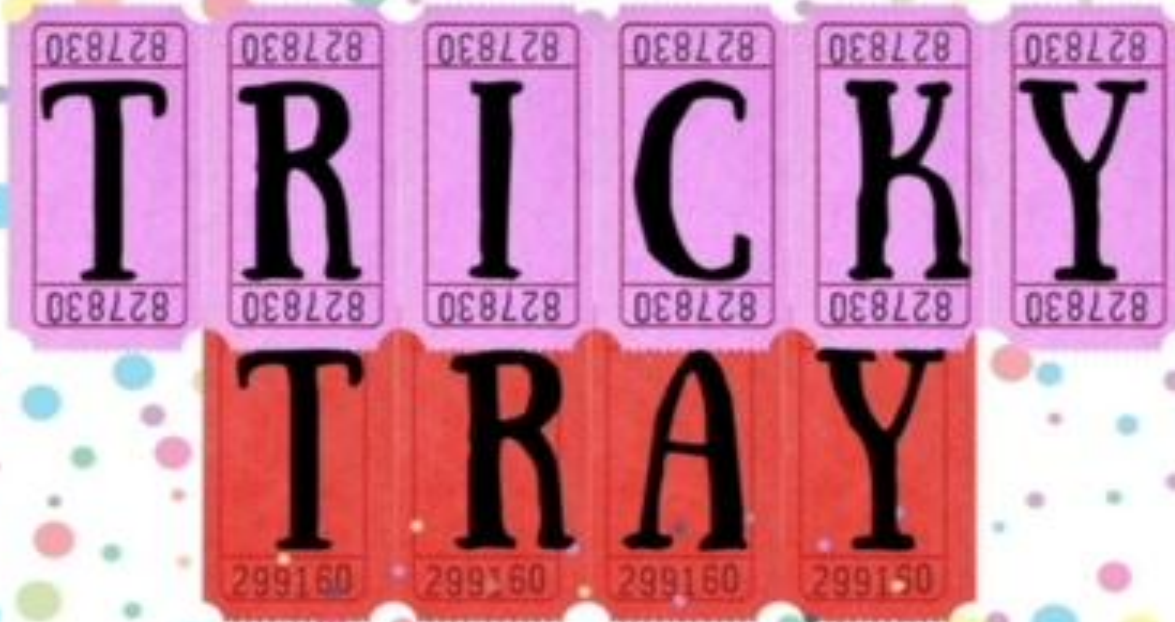
