RESTROOM PROCEDURES

Wildcats can be respectful, responsible, and safe in the restroom.

The “Wildcat Way”



- Wash hands with soap and water
- Flush toilet after use
- Give others privacy
- Keep your space
- Use quiet voices
- Report any problems to an adult
- Clean up after yourself
- Return to class quickly





HALLWAY PROCEDURES

Wildcats can be respectful, responsible,
and safe in the hallway.



The “Wildcat Way”



- Stay in line, with your hands and feet to yourself
- Stick Together!
- Stay on the right side of the hallway
- Always walk
- Respect hallway teaching and other areas of the building
- Level 0 (silence)





CAFETERIA PROCEDURES

Wildcats can be respectful, responsible,
and safe in the cafeteria.





The “Wildcat Way”

- Stay seated while eating
- Listen for directions
- Stay at your assigned table, do not travel to see friends
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Always walk
- Use inside voice (levels 1 & 2)
- Raise your hand for assistance and report any issues to an adult
- Follow adult directions
- Be polite and use good manners
- Clean up after yourself

Playground Safety



The “Wildcat Way”

- Stick Together
- All Sports/games should be non-contact.
- Sit on the swings...NO STANDING!
- Your body should be below the monkey bars...no sitting on top.
- Slides are for sliding down...not climbing up.
- STAY CLEAN!...stay out of the dirt or mud
- One person at a time...slides, swings, etc.
- FOLLOW ALL TEACHER RULES/INSTRUCTIONS
- Have fun!



BUS SAFETY

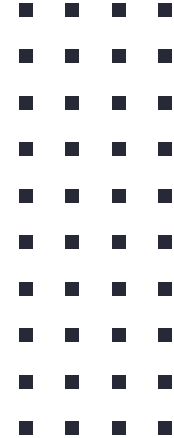

Bus Safety

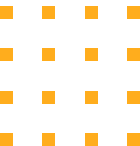


The “Wildcat Way”

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to self
- Stay in assigned seat.
- Level 0 when bus driver is talking or when the bus is stopped at train tracks.
- Follow directions
- Students are not allowed to bring food, drinks, or gum on the bus (water bottles are OK).
- The aisle of the bus should be kept free from objects.
- Keep belongings to yourself
- Report any problems to an adult
- Stay seated in your assigned spot
- Use a quiet voice (Level 1)
- Exit safely



WILDCAT INCENTIVES





Individual Incentive

Earn individually
Based on **character traits**
Demonstrate trait, give a ticket
Get ticket, mark chart.
First completed chart = wristband for trait (10 tickets)
Additional charts completed = drum
Filled chart/s goes in drum for monthly drawing.

Safe

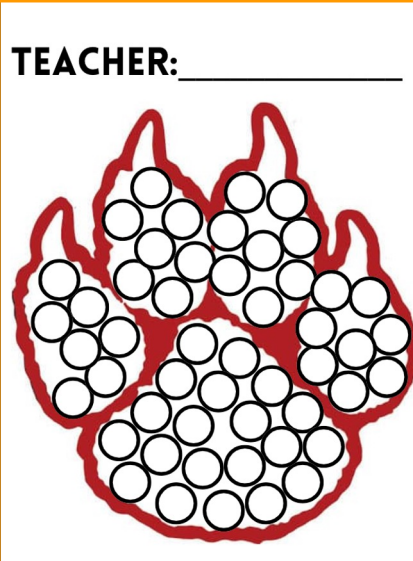
- Follow school-wide rules
