Purpose:

This multi-tabbed report displays the percentage of Advanced Placement (AP) course participation for each Nassau County public school district. The data reflect the number of students enrolled in a AP course, which is not necessarily the same as the number of students taking the AP Assessment. Note that some AP courses span multiple years, and some students may have been accidentally misassigned to AP courses by some districts. Data come from multiple NYSED State Report Card databases: course data are sourced from the "Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) databases; grade enrollment data are sourced from the Enrollment database.

The "Course Participation by Grade Level" tab displays both a column chart and table comparing the percentage of students enrolled in a particular AP course for each of the selected Nassau County public schools. Percentage of enrollment is the number of students enrolled in the course divided by the number of students enrolled in the selected grade.

The "All Grade Levels" tab displays a table containing AP course participation for each individual grade level (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and All Grades) for the selected AP Course. If the grade level column is blank, that indicates there aren't any AP Course Participants for that District / Grade Level. Average Grade Enrollment used for 'All Grades' is always based on a district's average enrollment for grades 10-12.

The 'Grade Enrollments' tab provides the grade enrollment values used in our "average grade enrollment" calculations. These data are sourced from the NYSED Enrollment database.

Please note that there are differences between the data on this report and the data found in the NYSED database and online platform. The following notes were written based on the format of the 2022 data.

- 1. The "All Students" subgroup was not provided directly in the NYSED database and was aggregated by Nassau BOCES.
- 2. NYSED did not provide grade enrollment totals in the AP course database. Enrollment data on this report were taken from the NYSED Enrollment Database. This may result in percentage differences on this report vs. the NYSED data site report.
- 3. Enrollment data for subgroups by grade level are not available in the Enrollment Database and therefore not available in this report.
- 4. The "All Grades" category was aggregated by Nassau BOCES and is not available on the NYSED website.
- 5. "All Grades" enrollment percentages are based on the average grade enrollment for grades 10, 11, and 12. Average grade enrollments may be inflated due to students enrolled in a course spanning multiple years, which may result in enrollment percentages that total more than 100%.
- 6. Although available on NYSED report card data site, NYSED did not provide NYS or county aggregates in their AP Database. The Nassau County benchmark provided on this report was calculated by Nassau BOCES and, therefore, might vary slightly from what is displayed on the NYSED report card data site. NYS benchmarks were not calculated for this report, but may be found on the NYS Report Card.
- 7. The districts available for selection on this report, along with those that appear on the Grade Enrollments tab, reflect only those districts that have AP course enrollments as of 2022 or later. Note that totaling these districts may not match the Nassau County enrollment totals not be not the regional benchmark, which includes all districts regardless of AP course enrollment.


AP Course Enrollment vs. Exam Proficiency






AP Course Enrollment vs. Exam Proficiency






Exam Proficiency vs. Exam Participation







