Overview: Students will have the opportunity to serve children in an elementary school. Serving as teachers' aide for four days, growing in empathy and knowledge of the challenges some students face daily.

 - possibly experience tutoring in multicultural settings
 - gain insight, appreciation, and understanding of the lives of our neighbors in each school community

Description:

As a volunteer you will tutor individual students, and work with groups of students needing focused attention and assistance. You may also help the classroom teacher with various classroom duties. Students are expected to dress professionally and always behave as admirable role models in the elementary schools.

Daily schedule:

Arrive CHCA Founders' Campus by 8:00 a.m. to participate in learning related to child development, learning styles, tutoring skills and daily expectations. Debrief past day experience and discuss strategies and tips with each other and teachers to learn and grow throughout the week.

Depart CHCA for school at 9:00 a.m.

Serve as needed in their assigned classroom

Lunch – students should pack a bag lunch and plan to eat with school children in the cafeteria.

Depart to return to CHCA before 2:45 each day.

This course is well suited to: Students who enjoy working one-on-one with elementary age students and can conduct themselves in an appropriate manner for a long period of time.

Cost: \$ 150

Additional costs: Students need a packed lunch each day,

Students should be dressed neatly in clothes that are not flashy or revealing in any way. Modest dress code applies.
