CLEAR BACKPACK POLICY

As a part of Richmond Public Schools' (RPS) ongoing efforts to enhance safety for students and staff members, clear backpack requirements will be in effect for the 2024-25 School Year. Students may carry a pouch no larger than 5.5 " x 8.5" to hold personal items and a regular lunch box no larger than 6" x 9" x 5". All bags are subject to search!

To Facilitate the transition to this new policy, RPS will provide one clear backpack for each student free of charge! Students may pick up their backpack at Kindergarten Orientation/Open House on Thursday, August. 15 from 4-6 pm.

KINDERGARTEN AND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Kindergarten and new student orientation will be held on Thursday, August 15th, at 4:00 pm. This is an opportunity for the kindergarten and new students to meet their teacher, see where their classroom is located, and find out more information about the school. Kindergarten students (only) should be dropped off in their classroom while parents attend the 45-minute info session in the auditorium. The PTA will be providing a pizza picnic and information on some opportunities at Fox from 5-6 pm.

OPEN HOUSE/SCHOOL SUPPLY DROP OFF

Again this year, you will have the option of dropping off your students' school supplies, seeing your classroom, and meeting the teacher before the first day of school. **Teachers will be available to receive any school supplies and meet students on Thursday, August 15th, from 4-6 pm.** Please keep in mind that this is a time to <u>briefly</u> meet the teacher, see the classroom, and drop off supplies, but not a time for an in-depth conference! **All are welcome to join the PTA for a pizza picnic from 5-6 pm.**

AFTERCARE

Currently, the YMCA has an aftercare program that meets at Fox at Clark Springs; You must register for the program and pay the required fee. This year, **the cost for the YMCA will be reduced to \$70 PER SEMESTER!** Space is limited, for more information and to register visit: https://www.ymcarichmond.org/programs/child-care.

SCHOOL COMMUNICATION = remind

Remind is a tool that allows 2-way messaging between teachers, schools, and families. RPS AND our school communicate with families through REMIND. If you are NOT receiving notifications via email, please contact the front office ASAP (804-780-6259) to ensure your contact information is up to date!

It is strongly recommended that you also **download the Remind app** on your phone and set it so that you receive text messages! The app is available in the Apple App Store and Google Play Android Store for FREE. Remember to "tag" RPS as well as Wiliam Fox Elementary (@wfesrva). This is STRONGLY recommended so that you receive all notifications promptly!

SCHOOL HOURS

Our school day is from 7:45 am to 2:45 pm each day. Students may be dropped off at school beginning at 7:30 am. At 7:30 am students may enter the building, eat breakfast and report directly to their classroom. All students should be in class by 7:45 am. Parents are not allowed to walk their children to class. Please say goodbye to your child out front at the "Goodbye Zone" (the sidewalk in front of the main doors) Students should NOT be dropped off at school prior to 7:30 am! They will not be allowed inside, and may not wait outside unattended. A 2024-2025 school calendar is enclosed so that you can mark important dates on your calendar.

INFORMATION CARD

The enclosed card should be attached to your child's shirt on the first day. This will assist our staff members in getting your children to their classrooms since parents are not allowed to walk children to the classroom door. Your child's teacher's name, room number, and grade are on the card. Please add your child's address, phone number, and dismissal arrangements so that we can ensure the safety of all of our students at dismissal time. Please print the information clearly and pin the card to your child's clothing.

ARRIVAL

Parents bringing children to school may utilize the "Kiss 'n Ride" lane from 7:30-7:45 am. Cars enter the Kiss 'n Ride lane from Harrison Ave. turning left onto Dance St. Drivers should pull up to the drop-off area, and beginning at 7:30 am, a staff member will open your car door, and your child should proceed to the front doors of the building. There is NO PARKING, or GETTING OUT OF YOUR CAR, ALONG Dance St. in the morning! Please be cautious when moving up to the drop-off point and follow all staff members' directions. Remember, school buses have the right of way, and drivers must obey ALL signs and staff member requests.

If you prefer to walk your child to the front doors of the building, you should park in the grassy-dirt field adjacent to the baseball field and walk your student (s) to the front door. There are no lines/parking spaces. PLEASE do not block each other in!

WHEN COMING TO FOX @ CLARK SPRINGS YOU SHOULD ALWAYS USE HARRISON AVE. TO DANCE ST. Visitors/caregivers should NEVER use any other surrounding streets to come to school.





BUS RIDERS

Bus schedules will be placed on the RPS homepage (www.rvaschools.net), and put on the front doors of the school by Thursday, August 15th. Fox staff members will meet the students on their bus at school. Students are to remain on the buses until met by staff each morning. Please discuss bus behavior with your child. He/she is to wait quietly at the bus stop, board the bus carefully, and remain seated until met at the school. Kindergarten and 1st Grade students must be accompanied by a caregiver at the bus stop. If a caregiver is not at the bus stop to pick up Kindergarten and 1st-grade students after school, the student will be returned to school and a caregiver will have to come to school to pick them up. Bus safety is very important.

DISMISSAL

Dismissal will begin at 2:35 pm. Please keep in mind that students MAY NOT be picked up early regularly from school to avoid waiting in the pick-up line. Students are expected to remain in class to finish out the school day, review the day's learning targets and hear afternoon announcements. Caregivers should park in the dirt/grassy parking lot off of Dance St. right after you make the left turn from Harrison (next to the baseball field). Again, there are no lines/parking spaces. PLEASE do not block each other in! After parking, parents should go to the table outside the gym doors to sign their student out. Parents will not be allowed in the building at dismissal time to go to classrooms to pick up students. Once students are signed out, they will be called for dismissal. Your child(ren) will be called to the gym door to meet you. Thank you in advance for your PATIENCE. The first couple of days of school may take longer until we get used to the system.

LUNCH PRICES

Again this year: All students currently enrolled in any Richmond Public School are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at <u>no charge</u> each day of the 2024-2025 school year! No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in the meal program without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

SUPPLY LISTS/CLASSROOM FEES

A list of requested school supplies and/or specific supply fees for your child's classroom is enclosed. We will not be accepting any payment at school. Please pay for all supplies/fees using the link indicated on the enclosed Supply List. We always accept and encourage additional supplies/money for fees if you are able to pay/send more.





PTA

Please plan on joining our PTA. Dues are \$10.00 per person or \$20 per family. We also encourage you to volunteer some time by helping with any of the programs offered by our very active PTA. Additionally, this year, our PTA is asking for a \$15 Activity fee. This fee will help to keep the many community events and enrichment programs for our students free! If you are able to pay above the \$15 this is encouraged and greatly appreciated!

Our first PTA meeting and "Back to School Night" will be held on Tuesday, August 27th, 2023 at 6:00 pm. Please plan on coming in to hear greetings from the principal and to meet the PTA, then travel into your child's classroom to meet your child's teacher(s) and learn about his/her classroom. The proposed PTA Budget for 2024-2025 is enclosed. The budget will be finalized at Back to School Night. Please take a look at the proposed budget and see all of the exciting enrichment and remediation programs, community-building activities, and teacher support that our wonderful PTA is proposing for this school year.
