****PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL ALL OF YOUR ITEMS****

FOR INDIVIDUAL STUDENT USE/ALL STUDENTS NEED THESE: *many of these can be reused from prior years! We expect that students have these items for use each day at school.*

- One 2 - 3 inch, sturdy, three ring binder (**file folder systems can be in the binder, but will not be used**) **Note: Many students choose to use a zipper binder with a laptop case**
- One 1-inch 3-ring binder (8th grade math)
- One set of dividers (4 core classes + WIN, 2 for electives, and PE/Health tabs)
- Lined paper (wide or college ruled) **Do not need the whole package in the binder**
- Four 70 page spiral bound notebooks ~ 70 pages no dividers for design, science, language arts, PE/Health and (returning students may use theirs from last year if there is room)
- One 100 page spiral notebook for social studies
- Spiral Bound Quad ruled notebook ~ 80/100 pages (Recommend Five Star; please no glue-bound or easy tear-out -- for 6th and 7th grade math)
- Loose leaf quad paper (8th grade math)
- Pencil pouch that clicks into your binder
- Pencils - **please** buy extra pencils for your child to leave in their locker
- Hand held pencil sharpener with shaving collector
- White board markers
- Glue sticks
- Earbuds – that will work in a Chromebook
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Calculator (scientific not graphing) – needs to come to school with you! **We will NOT provide calculators.**
- Scissors
- Highlighters- at least two different colors: can use neon colored pencils to reduce plastic waste
- One backpack
- "Crossing the Wire" by Will Hobbs
- "The Breadwinner" by Deborah Ellis
- "Seedfolks" by Paul Fleischman

FOR FIELD WORK: (On site visit days, students are expected to wear long pants and be prepared with required materials.) We will do a gear exchange at RC Picnic on August 15 and Wolf Day on August 22. Bring your gear to trade then if you have grown out of it.

The following are required items:

- leather gloves or leather palmed gloves
- rain gear: both pants and jacket
- rain proof boots
- reusable lunch box
- shoes appropriate for hiking - preferably waterproof
- reusable water bottle
- clipboard
- hand sanitizer
- warm hat and gloves

FOR COMMUNITY SUPPLY (WILL BE COLLECTED ON FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL):

- 6th graders bring – 3 X 5 lined index cards (one pack)
- 7th graders bring – 2 glue sticks
- 8th graders bring – 1 box of tissue
