

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DRESS CODE POLICY

BCCHS DRESS CODE 24-25

You must wear clothing that includes a top & bottom or the equivalent (dress, romper, etc.)

TOPS

- No crop tops/exposed midriff
- Can't be sheer (see-through) or expose undergarments, (bra straps showing is okay)
- Racerback tops are okay
- No strapless, deep V/scoop neck or off-the-shoulder tops

BOTTOMS

- Have to cover to the tips of your fingers when your arms are down.
- Can be no lower than the waist & can't expose undergarments
- No rips/tears above where your fingertips hit

HATS

- OK: BCCHS hats, Plain colored hats/beanies, college, fashion-style hats are okay
- NOT OKAY: Anything that hides your identity, major league sports, fashion logos

SHOES

 Need to be appropriate for all classroom activities & safe for hazards. Slippers are for spirit days only

<u>Clothing/jewelry/headgear can't:</u>

- Show, imply, advocate for, or advertise illegal/violent/lewd conduct or the use of any controlled substance (alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, etc.)
- Depict hate speech or target groups based on any protected classification
- Depict or imply pornography, nudity or sex acts
- Endanger students/staff (ie. spikes, chains)
- Denote gang affiliation/membership

Cell Phone Policy 9th

All classes taught by 9th Grade teachers are NO PHONE AREAS. Other teachers can follow the same policy if they choose.

- When you enter class, you will be required to place your phone in either a locked box or pocket chart.
- You will get your phone back at the end of the period.
- You are allowed to use your phone during passing periods & at lunch.

Consequences for not following the policy

A charge station
