

Tips to Help your Student Succeed

We need our parents/guardians to help us hold our students accountable.

Aeries Parent Portal

★ Monitor your student's Aeries portal for grades, attendance, and missing assignments.

Google Classrooms

Ask your student to log on to their Google Classrooms and click "View Your Work" to see what is "Turned In" or "Missing."

Communicate with Teachers

★ Communicate with your student's teachers through email or Parent Square


Attendance Page Link

- **★** The Law
 - Ed Code 48200: Compulsory Education: All students between the ages of 6 and 18 must attend school daily and on time.
- ★ School only gets harder when you stay home too much.
- Missing 10% of school, or about 15 days, negatively affects your grades.

That's just **two days a month** and that's known as **chronic absenteeism**.

A-G Grade Level Benchmarks We want ALL student to be eligible to apply to a University.

A-G requirements are the classes that students must take and pass with a C or **better** to be eligible to apply to a 4 year university.



Note: "D" is considered passing for graduation requirements, **not** for college!



How to Build a Competitive Academic Transcript We want ALL students to maximize their academic potential...

- Students can take Honors and Advanced Placement (AP)
 Courses
- Students have access to College classes offered through both the School for Advanced Studies (SAS) program (Advisor- Ms. Palacios) and through our Blue & Gold Center (Career Counselor- Ms. Zook)
- Students should retake any Ds or Fs from previous semesters (credit recovery classes & summer school) to meet A-G requirements and boost GPA.


