WHO??

THE PROCESS??

- Step 1: Must **HAVE** your Infinite Campus Information updated for the new year,
- Step 2: Must **HAVE** already purchase your school's parking pass,
- Step 3: Must pay \$75 fee (Checks and PTSO Painted Parking QR are accepted)
- Step 4: Must fill out all completed documents associated with the WGHS PTSO Reserved Painted Parking Spaces Application to the WGHS Front Office.

NOTE: Spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are given in order of COMPLETION and PAYMENT.

- **ONCE YOUR PAYMENT & APPLICATION** has been received: you will receive an email (at the email address you provide on the Design Request Form) letting you know: approved, not approved, or if any changes need to be made.
- **IF APPROVED:** You will receive your scheduled time slot with your approval email. You may **ONLY** Paint during the designated painting days that have been approved unless you have written approval by the Principal or Principal's Secretary.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- Upon purchasing my parking spot I will only use water-based exterior latex paint.
- I will check in with a school supervisor to have my paint approved before I paint.
- I will provide my own paint.
- I will not use spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space that is drawn for me.
- I will bring my own paint, brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space. If I park in someone else's spot, I will receive disciplinary action.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I will complete my painting during the designated painting days.
- No REFUNDS will be given.

If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my painting rights will be forfeited. If I paint anything unapproved in my spot, I will also forfeit my parking permit without refund and will be given a referral by your administrator.

ON PAINTING DAY:

What you need to get started:

- ✓ your copy of your approved design – so you will have your approved template to follow. You must follow the design exactly – no changes allowed.
- ✓ shade structure will be helpful
- ✓ a blanket or cardboard to kneel/sit on while painting. The pavement is hot!
- ✓ your paint (**MUST BE: WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX**)
- ✓ Water and Gatorade
- ✓ a broom to sweep off your spot before painting. (A battery-powered leaf blower works even better)
- ✓ paintbrushes, rollers, paint trays (rollers for “rough surface” work best)
- ✓ tape off your design space with painter’s tape
- ✓ After you are done painting...allow it to fully dry before walking or driving in space.

PROHIBITED:

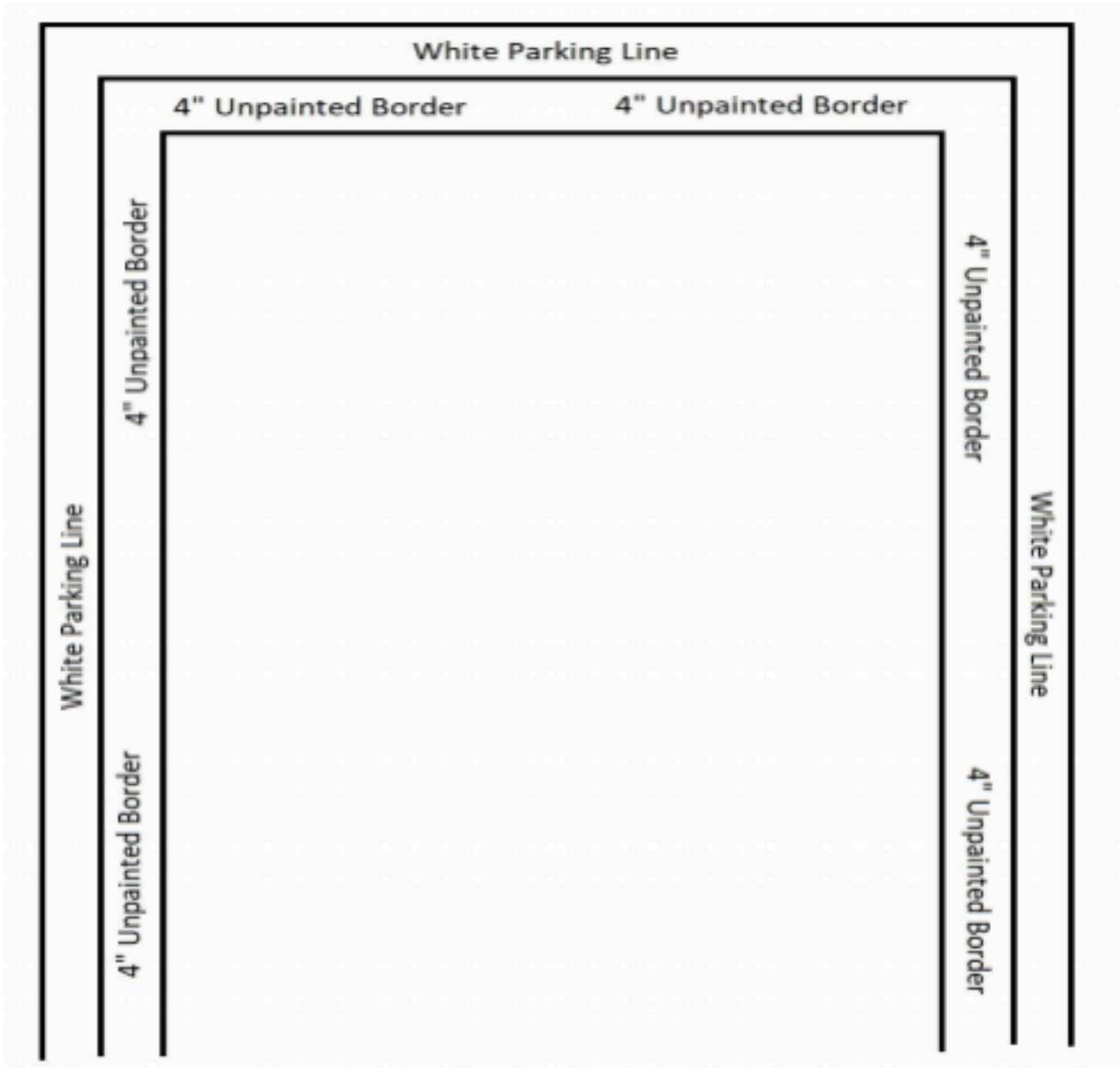
- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.
- No negative or rude language (BE NICE/BE KIND)
- No “gang-style tagging”
- No double entendres (Double meanings)
- Must be school-appropriate and follow all WGHS Student Handbook guidelines.
- You must include your name but no one else’s name. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. (**A boyfriend’s or girlfriend’s name is NOT allowed**)

If you paint any prohibited items in your space, we will paint over the parking space, you will face disciplinary action, and you will forfeit your school parking permit with no refund.
