**Students are not allowed to drop Honors, Pre-AP, Statewide Dual Credit (SDC), Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) courses. Therefore, it is recommended to have a 90 or higher average in the prerequisite class due to the academic rigor.**

After this date I will not be allowed change my course(s), even if the course(s) adversely affects my GPA or class rank. Lastly, I have reviewed the course description in the Program of Studies and have taken the appropriate prerequisite for the above course(s).*

**For Advanced Placement (AP) courses only:** I/we understand that students are required to pay for and take the AP exam in May. A payment of \$103 per AP class is required by Sunday, October 20, 2024. **Students who do not pay for and/or take the AP exam in May will not have the quality points added to their semester averages.**

**For Dual Enrollment (DE) courses only:** Students are required to maintain a “2.0” college average in the class to continue receiving funding from the State of Tennessee’s lottery funds. The 2.0 college average is in accordance with the post-secondary institutions grading system. Students who fall below a “2.0” college average, will be placed in the high school equivalent course for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. Funding amounts are subject to change.
