Students can earn college credit, skip intro-level courses, or both, at thousands of U.S. colleges and universities.

Each AP class requires a \$103.00 fee for the exam taken in May.



COMPRACTS:

Students wanting to take Honors, Statewide Dual Credit, AP and Dual Enrollment courses must complete a contract to request these classes.

Students are not allowed to drop Honors, Statewide Dual Credit, AP and Dual Enrollment courses after May 16th. It is recommended students have a 90 or higher average in the pre-requisite class due to the academic rigor.

Contracts require students to indicate their current Y1 average in the prerequisite class. This can be found in PowerSchool.






