



AP CLASSES:

We offer 17 AP classes at BHS. Advanced Placement, or AP classes, provide college level instruction helping prepare students for the rigorous coursework encountered in college.

Students can earn college credit, skip intro-level courses, or both, at thousands of U.S. colleges and universities.

Each AP class requires a \$103.00 fee for the exam taken in May.






