Curriculum	Bonham Middle School utilizes a high-quality curriculum that supports student success.			
Forms of Academic Assessments	Bonham Middle School has common formative assessments that every teacher gives. No matter the teacher, each child is assessed via the same assessment. MAP assessments are given three times per year to determine the student's individual measurement of academic proficiency. Unit assessments are provided by TEKS Resource System which models each assessment after the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness or STAAR test. Previous STAAR tests are released and utilized for assessment and instruction in addition to other curriculums.			
Expected Achievement levels on academic	Bonham Middle School tracks each child's growth throughout the year via local assessments (mentioned above). Each child has a folder where teachers help them track their own learning growth.
