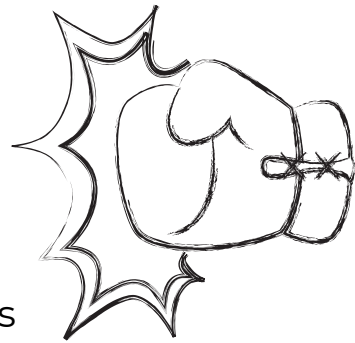
3rd Graders... Are you ready for battle?

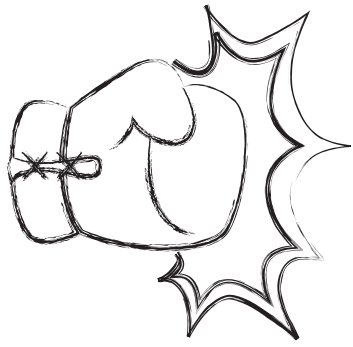

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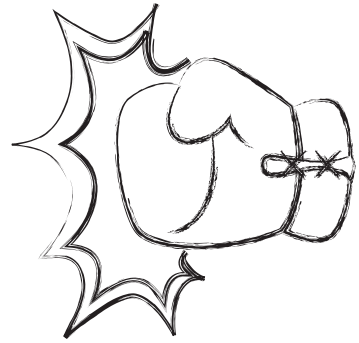
4th Graders... Are you ready for battle?

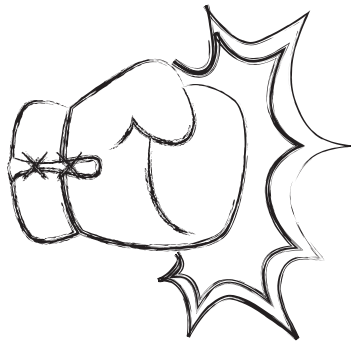

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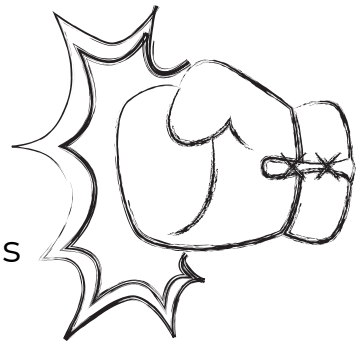
5th Graders... Are you ready for battle?
