



# Summer Scholars

The Central Islip Union Free School District offers several grant-funded programs during the summer of 2024. These programs serve students across grade levels, needs and interests. Funding provided through the American Rescue Plan and Title grants offers kindergarten through grade 12 students highly engaging and academically supportive summer opportunities.

## Summer Enrichment Program

The Summer Enrichment Program at Francis J. O'Neill Elementary School serves 300 kindergarten through sixth grade students. Ms. Tracy Rentz, the administrator, has created an Olympic-themed program. The program prioritizes science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics. Students build and code Ozobots, use applications to strengthen their reading and writing skills, and learn how to cook through lessons provided by Cornell Cooperative Extension.

# Title III Summer Immigrant Program

The Title III Summer Immigrant Program at Charles A. Mulligan Elementary School serves 100 students in grades one through six.

Mr. Brett MacMonigle leads the program, focusing on language acquisition and development for newly arrived students. The instructional staff includes bilingual, English as a new language, and music teachers, providing a rich experience for the district's newcomer students.

An art and wellness workshop is embedded into the program. Students become acclimated to the various disciplines, preparing them for a much smoother transition into the new school year in September.





# Extended School Year (ESY) Program

The Extended School Year program at Anthony Alfano Elementary School serves 75 students, ages 5-21. Eligible students are selected to participate in this six-week education program. Ms. Rebecca Garcia is the program administrator who has established an “Around the World” theme. Each week, students prepare meals from different countries. Additional activities include walking trips, yoga, dance, art, music and science lessons. The instructional staff includes elementary school teachers, psychologists and speech teachers.

# Title IV Summer Science Research Program


The Title IV Summer Science Research Program at Central Islip High School serves approximately 10 students. Ms. Roann Roderick's program offers secondary students opportunities to explore, research, problem-solve and experiment through hands-on learning. It aims to integrate science research with current events, addressing environmental and social issues through an interdisciplinary curriculum. In this program, students design and execute research projects for science competitions.
