Dual Certification - This employment opportunity is available to anyone who qualifies. A single eligibility list based on rank order will be generated from this recruitment. Current classified employees who qualify will be given seniority credit.

POSITION BENEFITS

Pay increases: The first pay increase for regular employees occurs after 6 months if the employee passes the probationary period. Pay increases occur annually thereafter, until top step is reached.

BASIC FUNCTION

Under the direction of the principal, assist the certificated teacher in delivering comprehensive vocal and dance instruction to middle and/or high school students participating in a show choir. This position involves guiding students through the foundational and advanced techniques of singing and choreography necessary for performing in beginning, intermediate, and competitive show choir levels. The IA will work closely with the lead teacher to cultivate students' musical talents, enhance their performance skills, and foster a collaborative and dynamic show choir environment. Responsibilities include providing vocal coaching, choreography assistance, and support during rehearsals and performances, as well as contributing to the overall development of the students' confidence, teamwork, and stage presence. Examination:

Applications may be screened to select the most qualified candidates.

The examination will consist of:

- A - Written job knowledge exam (30% of Total Score)
- B - Structured oral exam (70% of Total Score)

Some classifications require you to pass a physical examination. This examination is at the district's expense and the appointment is not assured until you have passed this examination. Applicants must attain a passing score of 70% on each part of the examination in order to be placed on the eligibility list. Should a large number of candidates pass the written exam, a higher passing score than 70% may be required to progress. Candidates who pass the written and panel interview will be placed on an eligibility list valid for six (6) months.
