Radio Frequency Notice

To: Parents

Minneapolis Public Schools recently adopted regulation 7010 B. The purpose of this regulation is to establish the District plans to conform to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC) requirements for radio frequency emissions on District premises. The regulation requires that for each building that has equipment that emits radio frequency, we notify parents that this equipment exists on the school's premise.

The intent of this notice is to inform all parents, that there is equipment on site at your child's school that emits radio frequency emissions. The equipment located on site is in compliance with FCC requirements.

In accordance with Minnesota Statute 123B.571, the Minnesota Department of Health and the Minnesota Department of Education, MPS has implemented its Radon Safety Management Plan. The Plan includes a program of radon testing, radon mitigation options and communications.

In accordance with the statute, MPS performs radon testing in school buildings every five years.
