Eligibility: Any student (grades 5-12) enrolled in Pearland ISD

<p>1. Submission of Entries</p>	<p>Entry fees are \$5.00 per entry. Entry fee is <i>non-refundable</i>. Only one entry per exhibitor per category for a maximum of two entries, which can come from the traditional art category or the photography category. This is a two-dimensional (2-D) art show, so no 3D artwork. Entries and fees will be completed through <u>Webstore only</u>. All artwork must be matted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acceptable mediums for artwork include construction paper, pastels, acrylic paint, ink, chalk, watercolor, marker, charcoal, oil paint, pen, air brush, scratchboard, pencil, crayon, dye, colored pencils, and tempera paint. • Certain materials may not be used in artwork including sand, glitter glue, plastic figures, wax, living things, beads, stencils, printed material, pre- packaged or pre-cut craft or art kits, feathers, or any man-made products. • Acceptable sizes are minimum including mat = 11” x 14” and maximum including mat = 18” x 24”. • No framed artwork will be accepted but must be matted. • Western and Rodeo themed artwork tend to sell better. This is a livestock show.
<p>2. Submission of Art Exhibits</p>	<p>Teachers will bring submissions to the Richard L. Wagoner Agricultural Facility Wednesday, September 07, 2022. Late submissions will not be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each entry must include a completed ID card attached to the front of the artwork. • An entry form should be taped to the back. Student must mark the appropriate category and make sure that all paperwork has the necessary signatures. • All 2D artwork must be matted or mounted with matboard that will complement the artwork. Construction paper and poster mats will not be accepted. • Certain subjects are categorized as unacceptable for the Pearland Livestock Show and Career Expo. Artwork depicting these subjects will be disqualified. Subjects include, but are not limited to; violence, weapons, gang activity, drug use, nudity, or satanic.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certain types, styles and methods of artwork are not permitted and will be disqualified. These include entries made from or with mechanical or electronic devices such as with the assistance of opaque or overhead projectors, computer-generated or computer enhanced art or otherwise professionally or mechanically reproduced images. • No wood burning, bas-relief, artwork created on glass, mirror or any reflective surface.
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<p>3. Participant Responsibilities</p>	<p>Entries must be the original work of the student. Copies of any published artwork or mimeographed works are not acceptable. All work must be from 2022 and may include artwork entered in the 2022 Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. Other responsibilities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Artwork should not be signed when entered. Artwork should be signed only after the student is notified their piece will be up for auction. Judges will be allowed to award auction lots from current 2022, year artworks only. • Students in grades 5 - 12 must have completed / signed entry form & ID card. • Students in grades 5 - 12 must agree to participate in the live or silent auction if their artwork is chosen. Each student must initial the participation box under the Auction Release section of the entry form. Entry form must also be signed by the student and parents.
<p>4. Eligibility</p>	<p>To be eligible to participate, Pearland ISD students must be passing coursework in accordance with Pearland ISD Grading Policy & Extracurricular Activity Guidelines.</p> <p>The Grand Champion art winner will be allowed to compete in the following years' art contest, but he / she will only be allowed to advance as far as the Reserve Grand Champion.</p>
<p>5. Judging Criteria</p>	<p>The following criteria will be considered when artwork is judged. Creativity and composition will be weighted at 50%; technical skill and excellence will be weighted at 50%.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Originality: Is the concept or idea original? Is it the student's own work? • Creativity: Does the piece of art show imagination? Is the subject matter unique? Is the interpretation innovative? • Skill: Skill is assessed based on the age of the artist. • Excellence: in composition in drawing and painting/photography

6. Sale/Awards	<p>Grades 5-8: There will be one (1) Best of Show from grades 5-6, one (1) Best of Show from grades 7-8, and one (1) Special Merit Ribbon for grades 5-8. The two (2) Best of Show selections will be placed in the silent auction at the buyer's dinner. 3rd, 4th, 5th, and special merit places awarded do not go to auction.</p> <p>Grades 9-12: One (1) Grand Champion, one (1) Reserve Grand Champion, five (5) Best of Show Ribbons in drawing and painting. Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion - live auctioned, and the 5 Best of Shows - silent auction.</p> <p>All grades: One (1) Best of Show in photography awarded - silent auction</p> <hr/> <p><u>Students will be required to have their Social Security Number and fill out a W9 Tax Form. Students must also plan to attend the auction and dinner unless participating in another PISD event.</u></p> <p><u>Due to Covid-19, plans for hosting the PLSCE and competitions could change and / or be cancelled</u></p>
7. Dress Code	<p>Visual Arts students should wear the following attire for the show:</p> <p>Males: slacks, or appropriate jeans, and collared shirt Females: slacks, appropriate length skirt, or appropriate jeans, and collared shirt</p> <p>Visual Arts students should wear the following attire for the sale: Males: slacks (no jeans), dress shirt, tie optional Females: slacks (no jeans), dress or skirt of appropriate length, appropriate blouse</p> <p>NO SHORTS, CUT OFFS, RAGGED JEANS, T-SHIRTS OR TANK TOPS</p>

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
