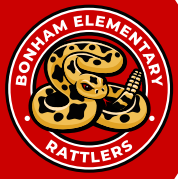
CAMPUS MISSION

PTO

Bonham PTO has a full board and is very active and fully supports the students and staff at Bonham Elementary.

RAGE (Rattlers Are Great Examples)

This is a 5th grade opportunity to be leaders that involves doing jobs around the school. A few examples include the daily morning show, raising the flags, opening car doors to greet our families, trash pick-up, and shelving library books.

Student Ambassadors

This is a 5th grade opportunity where students are officers of a future student council. Students have a voice in welcoming new students, assisting with events during the year, decorating for events, and in general sharing ideas to make school an awesome place to be.

Friday Clubs

On Fridays we have clubs for all grades K-5 where students choose their interest each semester. A few opportunities include art, stem, fitness, team sports, chess, cosmetology, and Minecraft.

AWARDS, RECOGNITIONS, HIGHLIGHTS

- Bonham is a Capturing Kids Hearts National Showcase School.
- Bonham Cheer Squad - students in grades 3-5 have the opportunity to be coached in cheer and dance to prepare to perform both inside and outside of school.
- Bonham Robotics Squad - students in grades 4-5 have the opportunity to compete within the district and outside of school in both Lego robotics and VEX robotics.
- Our PTO launched a fundraiser last year with sights on a virtual reality classroom setup as well as stand-alone playground equipment and we were able to purchase both.
- We award a student weekly with a Rattler of the Week sign to place in their yard.
- We award two students each nine weeks with a Rockin' Rattler sign to place in their yard to represent outstanding citizenship.
- We award one student a month with a Remarkable Rattler sign to place in their yard representing their outstanding representation of the monthly character trait.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT OPPORTUNITIES

We invite families to participate in grade-level parent meetings, open house twice a year, Ice Cream Social, pep rallies every nine weeks, Bring Your Dad to School Day, Grandparents Celebration, Math and Science Nights with Dads, Book Fair, Fall Festival, Spring Dance, Field Day, Little Olympics, and one event every nine weeks as our Brag Board Celebrations like color run and waterslide day, career day, music programs, opportunity to participate in Campus Advisory Council.

We love parent involvement and want positive adults to be able to interact with our students. Volunteers must complete a VIPS application and have an annual background check completed by the district on file before being considered for volunteer duties.
