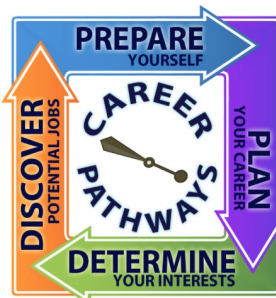
Online Registration open through November 18th
