


TEST TAKING SKILLS

Answer all the questions you know FIRST

Watch for key words or terms

DEDUCTIVE REASONING

The process of reaching logical conclusions by employing logical reasoning

Study the question-what is it asking?

If questions include a paragraph to read and questions to answer, read the QUESTIONS FIRST so you know what you are looking for

Look at similar or related questions- they may provide clues

Eliminate options you know are incorrect

True or False

Watch for qualifying words (never, always, all none) and remember, the ENITRE statement must be true for the

Multiple Choice

Look for the BEST
answer
Eliminate incorrect
answers
Pay close attention to
wording

Read all items before starting

Check off items as you use them
