

Attendance

Students must have 90% positive attendance.

- Includes excused <u>and</u> unexcused absences
- Under 90% = no extra curricular activities (dances, sports, senior activities, etc.)
- Considered chronically absent if below 90% and is reported to the State
- Other consequences can occur with unexcused absences or tardies

Supporting Students with Tardies

- It is important for students to be on time to class. If your student is having trouble arriving to class on time, please reach out to their Assistant Principal.
- In the first few days, there is some flexibility while students learn where their classes are.
- If a student is tardy to the same class six times, they will be assigned a lunch detention.
- Sobrato holds several attendance competitions throughout the year to promote positive attendance.

Electronic Devices Expectation

Sobrato High School will be implementing a cell phone policy in order to limit distractions, create a positive environment, and provide common expectations across all classrooms.

- 1. Daily expectation is that **phones are stored in a phone caddy** in the classroom at the start of class. This expectation also applies during tutorial period.
- 2. Daily expectation is that **earbuds or headphones are in backpacks** and backpacks are on the floor at the beginning of the class period.
- 3. Devices **stay in the classroom** when students use the restroom, or leave during class.
- 4. **Devices stay in phone caddy.** Devices can only come out of the caddy with permission from the teacher.


