#### **Request for Class Changes**

Parents will receive information about child's classroom teacher when they are invited to sign up through the Veracross Parent Portal for their Onboarding Appointment. St. John's kindly asks that parents do not make requests for their child to be changed to another class. The process of building classes, and for assigning students to particular teachers, is an incredibly challenging and complex process. Last spring, teachers – in collaboration with specialists and administration – began the work to ensure that each student is placed appropriately. We ask that you have good faith in our work in ensuring a successful year for your child.

### First Day of Kindergarten Parent Gathering: Join Us After Drop-Off

Please join us at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 21, in the Multipurpose Room (MPR) for a brief gathering of Kindergarten parents after you have dropped your child off in the classroom. Our Acting Head of School, Mrs. Grogan, and Elementary Division Principals, Mr. Bourke and Mrs. McLennan, will introduce themselves to those whom they have not yet met. They will share a few thoughts with you about the Kindergarten year and listen to any of your reflections.

### **Attention Kindergarten Parents: Important Information from Health Office**

The California Department of Public Health and Orange County Department of Education mandates that your child meet the immunization requirements in order to attend Kindergarten.

Please submit a current copy of one of the following documents:

A copy of your child's yellow California Immunization Card OR

A copy of the immunization record from your doctor's office

These mandatory documents are due to the Health Office on or before Friday, August 16, 2024. California law requires that all immunizations be up to date in order for a child to attend the first day of Kindergarten. There are NO exceptions to this rule. Updated copies of immunization records must be submitted for all incoming Kindergarten students regardless of whether or not they attended St. John's Early Childhood Center.
