2024-2025 Bell Schedule

Please note a change to the bell schedule on Thursday.

The purpose of access time at the end of the day is to provide targeted support for students who need extra help, particularly those with a D or F grade. During this time, these students will receive additional assistance through Responsive Scheduling with their class teacher, allowing us to focus on improving their academic performance. Attendance will be taken to ensure participation.

For students who do not have a D or F grade, this time still offers valuable opportunities. They can visit teachers for make-up quizzes, tests, or extra help if needed. Alternatively, they may leave for the day if they do not require additional assistance from a teacher. This flexible approach ensures that all students have the resources they need to succeed while encouraging those who need it to improve their grades.

Introducing the Campus Parent Absence Request Tool

Families,
Exciting news! In the Spring a few Jeffco Schools tested out the Campus Parent Absence Request Tool, which allows families to report same-day or upcoming absences through Campus Parent. The feedback from both schools and families has been overwhelmingly positive. Families rated their experience using the tool as "satisfied" and "very satisfied." They appreciated the convenience and ease of use:

- "It was fast, easy, and I like it better than calling the attendance line to leave a message."
- "Easy to use. Didn't need to talk to anyone or leave a voice message. Must for all schools."
- "Easy, convenient, and trackable - I can see requests that have been submitted."

Based on positive pilot feedback, the Absence Request Tool is now available to all schools for the 2024-25 school year! Below you will find resources about the Absence Request Tool and how to use it.

What is the Campus Parent Absence Request Tool?

The Campus Parent Absence Request Tool is a function within Infinite Campus (IC) that improves the reporting of excused absences for families. Families can use the Campus Parent Absence Request tool to report same-day or upcoming absences with ease. We encourage you to use this new system. But don't worry, the old system is available to continue using if you prefer.

Existing Families: Please update your Campus Parent Portal

Existing families should go to Campus Parent Portal to update their account and verify household information, student information, emergency contact information, and sign their agreements through the Annual update process.

- The annual update will be open from around August 1st through September 15th
- This is the only time that parents can update their opt out information.

LOCKERS: We have **limited** lockers available. We will have a locker request form, QR code posted in the commons starting the first week of school. Students who wish to use a locker at GMHS will need to fill out the locker request form. Lockers are only available in the U hall and across from the HUB. You will receive a locker agreement in your student email and once the agreement has been submitted, you will get a locker and combo that will appear in your Infinite Campus account under More -> Lockers.

STUDENT PARKING: Parking Fees: \$125 for the school year. Every month the fee will go down to \$12.50. For example, on September 1st the parking fee for the school year will be \$112.5. Fall only \$62.50. Spring only \$62.50 and again the prorated amount will take effect each month.

SENIOR PHOTO SPECS

You can choose to have a professional photographer take your senior photo or do it yourself. Either way, your photo will be required to follow the following specs/requirements in order to be a part of the GMHS Yearbook.

- A. 2x3 digital image (or similar ratio). Photos that are Landscape and not Portrait will be cropped.
- B. RGB
- C. **300ppi high resolution image (cell phone photos do not always take this high of a quality of image, and photos downloaded from Snapchat or Instagram are NOT high quality.)**
- D. Do not crop photos close to the top of the head, send square photos from Instagram or ones taken in the Snapchat App as they are not high enough quality and will appear pixelated.
- E. **NO SUNGLASSES.** We must be able to see both eyes of the subject.
- F. No firearms, blood, alcohol, tobacco, inappropriate gestures, inappropriate attire (such as too revealing clothing or brands associated with the things above)
- G. We cannot accept pictures that show too much cleavage or too much skin.
- H. **Students can look past the camera and not at it, but both eyes and most of the face must be visible to the camera. NO INSTAGRAM POSES WITH FACE TURNED TO THE SIDE.**
- I. Pets are fine.
- J. **Vertical head and shoulders pose (horizontal photos will be cropped to be vertical if submitted)**
- K. No watermarks.
- L. If you use a photographer, they will send in your picture on your behalf.
