- o Receive your Student ID card
- O Turn in your Student Emergency card from your Aeries Parent Portal
- Turn in current Tdap immunization (if not previously turned in)
- O Pick up Preliminary Class Schedule and Student Planner
- o Check out textbooks
- O Purchase PE clothes and Yearbook (cash or check ONLY)
- Complete your Volunteer Form and PTSA membership (optional)

Please note that class schedules will not be available earlier than the assigned time. Also, everyone will receive an official class schedule in their homeroom on the first day of school. ## First Day of School

The first day of school for all students will be **Tuesday, August 20, 2024.** We will be on a regular schedule. Gates will open at 7:30 a.m. for all students and classes will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. Students will be released at 2:25p.m. Please note that

## Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up

When dropping off or picking up students before or after school, please use the drive-thru circle in front of the Gym on 18th Street. Using the circle reduces the amount of traffic on 18th Street before and after school and enhances student safety.

Please drive carefully in all drop-off and pick-up areas for the safety of all students, staff, and guests. Also, please remember that stopping or parking in designated red zones is prohibited at any time.

Students may ride bicycles, skateboards, and scooters to school, but they should walk any time they are on school property or on sidewalks in front of the school. Bicycles, skateboards, and scooters must also be locked up at the bike rack located near the front office while school is in session.

All students should be picked up or on their way home by 2:45 p.m. (or 1:45 p.m. on Wednesdays) unless they are staying for tutoring or to get help from their teachers.
