



Supply List for Prekindergarten 2024-2025










Please label everything with your child's name with a permanent marker.



	Two (2) reusable water bottles	One bottle remains in school, and one bottle travels with the student between school and home. There will be NO use of the water fountains. Please label it with your child's name.
	Two (2) season-appropriate change of clothing	Please include underwear and socks. Please place everything in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name.
	Lunch box with reusable eating utensils	Please avoid using disposable items such as plastic forks, spoons, and sandwich bags.
	Snacks and lunch(Unless ordering from the school lunch program)	Please note that we are a nut-free school . No bars with nuts, including granola bars, are allowed.
	One (1) pair of indoor shoes to be kept in school	We request no flip flops or slip-on shoes.
	Four (4) boxes of tissues	For classroom use.
	Four (4) bottles of disinfectant wipes	For classroom use.
	Four (4) packs of baby wipes	For classroom use.
	YHIS t-shirt	All children will be in a school t-shirt on field trips.
	One (1) school backpack that can comfortably hold a RED plastic pocket folder and a lunch box.
