



Supply List for 3rd Grade 2024-2025



Two (2) reusable water bottles	One bottle remains in school, and one bottle travels with the student between school and home. There will be NO use of the water fountains. Please label it with your child's name.
One (1) bottle of hand sanitizer	Students will use it while they are at school.
Three (3) packs of disinfectant wipes	Students will use it to wipe down desks.
Two (2) season-appropriate change of clothing	Please include underwear and socks. Please place everything in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name.
Lunch box with reusable eating utensils	Please avoid using disposable items such as plastic forks, spoons and sandwich bags. NO glass containers. Please label the box with your child's name.
Snacks and lunch (unless ordering from the school lunch program)	Please note that we are a nut-free school . No bars with nuts, including granola bars, are allowed.
One (1) pair of indoor shoes	We request NO flip-flops or slip-on shoes.
Four (4) boxes of tissues	For classroom use.
YHIS T-shirt	All children will be in a school T-shirt on field trips.
One (1) school bag that can comfortably hold a 3-ring binder.	Please note that the backpack will be hung on a hook on the wall.
One tablet or laptop to bring to school for individual use in class.	
One set of headphones: the headphone that can be used with students' personal devices.	
One (1) pencil case.	The pencil case should always have two sharpened pencils and one eraser. A handheld pencil sharpener is optional. Your child is responsible for having the pencil case ready and in his/her backpack every day.
Two (4) large glue sticks	
One (1) pack of (12) writing pencils.	
Three (3) highlighters (yellow, orange and green)	
One (1) pair of scissors.	Labeled with your child's name.
One (1) pack of (24 colors) colored pencils.	Labeled with your child's name.
One (1) pack of (24 colors) washable markers.	Labeled with your child's name.

Five (5) dry erase markers	Labeled with your child's name.
One (1) ruler with centimeter and inch markings	Labeled with your child's name.
Two 2-inch 3-ring binders (of white or plain colors; no zippers)	Labeled with your child's name.
Two (2) wide-ruled composition books.	Not wire bound; <i>not college ruled</i> .
Six (6) heavy duty 2 pocket prong plastic folders.	Blue (Homework), Red (Math), Orange (Chinese), Green (Science & Music), Yellow and Purple (English). Students may re-use old folders.
