iReady Diagnostic Administration

iReady Math and Reading Diagnostic assessments must be administered to students the week of August 12th. On Monday and Tuesday, each student K-5 will take the math portion of the diagnostic. On Wednesday and Thursday, each student K-5 will take the ELA portion of the iReady diagnostic. Any student who misses a day of the iReady administration will participate in make-ups on Friday, August 16th. Please see the attached flyer to learn more about the iReady Diagnostic.

Participate Remote Days

Having our students in school each and every day is a priority for us here at HFE. Approved Remote Learning Days are a new addition to the Fulton County attendance policy as of last year. Each student is able to take 5 approved "participated remotely" learning days each semester. These can be used when you have a special family event, required travel, etc. These days must be requested at least 5 days in advance and require principal's approval. These days may not be used on testing days. Here is how the process works:

- 1. Parent notifies student's homeroom teacher of wanting to take participate remote learning days.
- 2. Use this link to inform our Data Clerk of the days you intend to use for Participate remote https://forms.office.com/r/ED0Rgwaf6h
- 3. Teachers will provide work that must be completed within 5 days of the absence Please reach out to Heather Klinzing klinzingh@fultonschools.org with any questions.

Carpool Reminders

Thank you all for a smooth 1^{st} week of carpool. Please let us know if you need a new number for carpool. A few reminders –

- wait until you pass the designated sign before your child exits the car.
- have your children exit from the right-hand side do not get out of your car. We have adults to help open the doors if needed.
- if you need to buckle your child in after picking up in the afternoon, please go around the loop (where the turtle is) and park on the side to buckle your child.
- refrain from being on your cell phone during carpool.

Upon entering the school to volunteer you will be asked to show your ID, sign in on our computer, and wear a name tag for the duration of your visit. Please make sure the name tag is clearly visible at all times.
