

As we strive to maintain a focused and safe learning environment, we would like to remind you of one of our school policies:

- Please dispose of any drink other than water before entering school. Our staff has been instructed to ask students to dispose of non-water drinks to prevent spills that could be damaging and disruptive to learning. Only water is permitted because it is less likely to stain or cause damage if spilled.
- Additionally, eating is not allowed in the classroom. After lunch, students will dispose of all food and other drinks besides water before leaving the cafeteria.
 - Food is not allowed in classrooms to prevent distractions and potential messes, helping us maintain focus. Keeping our learning spaces clean is essential for a conducive learning environment.
- Please note that guardians and students are not permitted to bring or have fast food delivered to the school premises.

Picking up your child requires a photo ID. Please do not park in the bus lane after 2:30 pm to avoid being blocked in by the buses.


