<b>SCHOOL ORGANIZATION</b>	Six periods daily on Mondays, Odd/Even blocks, with 3 periods a day on Tuesdays-Fridays. Two semesters, 18 weeks each.			
<b>VISALIA COMMUNITY</b>	Visalia is a city of 146,073 located midway between San Francisco and Los Angeles. The city is an urban center for light-industrial and agri-business. There are 26 elementary schools (K-6), a newcomer language center, 5 middle schools (7-8), 4 comprehensive high schools (9-12), a continuation high school, an adult school, a charter independent study school, a k-8 charter home school, and a charter technical early college high school.
