

## 2024-2025 Flexible Instruction Days

Dear Parents & Guardians,

The Lakeview School District has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) for up to five Flexible Instruction Days (FID) for the 2024-2025 school year. These days can be used in the case of an emergency, like weather, when technology may not be at home with all students. When a Flexible Instruction Day is used, the day does not need to be made up. Attendance, access to learning, and access to health care/resources are the three criteria required by PDE. A FID packet with five days worth of assignments is being sent home with all students that can be used in the case of an emergency school closure. **Please keep these packets in a safe place.** 

## **Attendance**

Students will be expected to check-in with their homeroom teacher at **8:00** to be marked present for the day. Please review our attendance policy if you have questions regarding excused/unexcused absences. Students may check in via ParentSquare, Google Classroom, or by calling the office of the school your child attends to report your student is working and present for the day. The easiest way is to connect with your child's teacher via ParentSquare.

## **Access to Learning**

Complete the assigned work either via the hard copy that is being sent home or the posted in Google Classroom (upper grades). Teachers are available throughout the day via ParentSquare. All assignments are required to be completed and returned on the next in-person learning day to be marked present for the FID.

## **Access to Health Care/Resources**

Please contact the school nurse via ParentSquare if you have a health related concern.

If you have questions on a FID, contact your child's teacher first. Please remember that an **attendance check-in and work completion** are required to be marked present for the day. It is very important that you are signed up for the Lakeview School District all-call system. Thank you for your continued support.
