Laptop Distribution:

District devices will be distributed to students at the middle school. This will happen during the school day at a time to be determined. Students will receive their devices only after their parent/guardian has completed the contact update form and medical information form on PowerSchool.

Gym Uniforms

Students will not be required to wear a KAMS gym uniform for their gym classes this year. Students will change for gym class, and gym clothing must follow the middle school's dress code, and sneakers must be worn. Gym teachers will explain the dress expectations during the first gym classes of the year. Students wishing to purchase a KAMS gym uniform may do so by visiting the main office.

Student Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures:

Students who are walking or being dropped-off should arrive by 7:35 am at the latest. For the safety of everyone involved in the morning commute, please follow these procedures (<u>Please</u> note changes in procedures):

- Students walking must stay on the sidewalk and cross at designated crosswalks
- Parents dropping off students in the morning must turn left into the Commons parking lot, proceed to the bottom of the lot for drop-off, and loop through the parking lot to the Constitution Boulevard exit. This is for the safety of students using the crosswalk to the Commons.
- There is no parking in the side lot along the curb while waiting for after school pick up. This area is needed for athletic buses. Parents can pull curbside for parent pick-up as soon as the buses leave.
- Students will be dismissed from the front of the building and will not be permitted to exit from the side exit.

Access to PowerSchool:

PowerSchool offers students and parents access to their individual grade and attendance records. Please note that Parents have a separate login than their students.
