

# Scarlet Oaks is a Uniform School

As a Career Technical School, all students are expected to be in a lab-specific uniform all day, every day at Scarlet Oaks.

Lab uniforms are chosen specifically by each lab instructor. Why?

- Safety in the Lab Workplace
- Professionalism
- Future Job placement expectations
- Uniform includes clothing *and* footwear
- Ease of financial choice for students

**But I left it at...**

*Unfortunately*, if you are not in uniform, you will not be able to be in your Lab class that day, but you will be able to attend Academic classes, with a Dean's approval.

**Uniforms are a Process not a problem.** However, if a student's lack of daily uniform becomes a concern, the student will be reported to their dean and sent to the office. If it is an ongoing concern, the student's household will be contacted so that uniform issues are resolved.

**All Students, Every Day**

Students are in uniform all day every day. For safety reasons at Scarlet Oaks, the following are prohibited:

- Shorts
- Sweats/Yoga pants
- Slides
- Open-toed shoes
- Nighttime wear including bonnets, slippers or pjs
- Clothing with vulgar or inappropriate message

**What else do I need to know?**

Most Labs will offer additional items such as **Scarlet** and program specific t-shirts and other items for sale during the 1st quarter, which **are** considered uniform.

Some Labs will encourage students to bring extra uniforms or shoes in case they get dirty from a typical lab day.
