

MAYFIELD INTRAMURALS

*Intramurals: - recreational sports organized within a set geographic area
(example- Mayfield Elementary)*

- a. Giving Mayfield students in 5th and 6th grade an opportunity to play and learn team sports with the emphasis on school work and attitude (reward).*
- b. Sportsmanship- to teach players with different talent levels how to get along and work in small groups to be successful.*
- c. Player Participation- based on their grades (staying on task) and behavior (no discipline reports)*

Intramurals:

Giving Mayfield students in 5th and 6th grade an opportunity to play and learn team sports with the emphasis on school work and attitude (reward).

Positive Behavior:

(A) School Work:

- 1. Player must be putting their best effort in completing all assignments to participate.*
- 2. Player must have at least a 1.5 GPA to continue to play intramurals (same as high school eligibility).*
- 3. Player will sit out if not completing their assignments.*
- 4. Removed from that intramural sport if player has to sit out 3 times for missed assignments.*

(B) Behavior (Discipline Referrals):

- 1. Reward to play intramurals at Mayfield.*
- 2. 3 Strike Rule:*
 - a. A player will be suspended one game for the first Minor Infraction (Strike 1).*
 - b. A player will be suspended again from that intramural sport for the 2nd Minor Infraction (Strike 2).*
 - c. A player will be removed from intramurals for the 3rd Minor Infraction or the 1st Major Infraction (Strike 3).*

Players are allowed to wear their uniform on game day.
