FELONY CHARGES MAY BE FILED AGAINST ANY PERSON(S) COMMITTING AN AGGRAVATED ASSAULT OR BATTERY UPON ANY SCHOOL EMPLOYEE. <u>21 OK Stat § 650.7 (2023)</u>

"The superintendent or principal of any school shall have the authority to order any person out of the school building and off the school property when it appears that the presence of such person is a threat to the peaceful conduct of school business, school activities, and/or school classes."

Any person who refuses to leave after being ordered to do so by the superintendent or principal shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
