“The superintendent or principal of any school shall have the authority to order any person out of the school building and off the school property when it appears that the presence of such person is a threat to the peaceful conduct of school business, school activities, and/or school classes.”

## VISITOR EXPECTATIONS

### LANGUAGE/ DECORUM

Please do not use profane or inappropriate language on school premises.

### SIGN IN ON RED KIOSK

- Please scan DL or ID to receive visitor badge.
- Display visitor badge while on premises.
- Sign out when leaving.

### WEAPONS

Use or possession of dangerous or offensive weapons are not allowed on the premises or property of Mustang Public Schools.

### TRESPASSING

Any person who refuses to leave after being ordered to do so by the superintendent or principal shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

### SMOKING/ SUBSTANCES

Smoking, along with consuming alcohol or any illegal substances, is prohibited at all times.

### PHOTO & VIDEO

Taking photographs or recording videos is not permitted unless consent has been sought for the relevant school activity.

### UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

Including/Not Limited To:

- Threats, bullying, harassment;
- Profanity/offensive language;
- Insulting, abusing, or intimidating behavior;
- Racism or discrimination;
- Physical aggression;
- Damaging school property.

**Any unauthorized person on school property will be reported to the Principal/designee. Unauthorized or disorderly persons will be asked to leave and must do so immediately. Refusal to leave will result in police intervention.**

### ENCOURAGED BEHAVIOR(S)

Including/Not Limited To:

- Be Kind. Be Polite.
- Act as if someone is watching...because our students notice you.
- Ensure your child attends school on time and regularly.
- Contact the teacher, then principal to resolve concerns.
- Show respect at all times.
