Dear Parents of the Baking & Pastry Arts Students,

In preparation for the start of the 2024-2025 school year, we have comprised a list of supplies, clothing requirements, and Board of Health regulations.

Supplies

- 3 ring binder
- 4 pens
- 4 pencils
- 1 Black Sharpie
- 1 inexpensive calculator
- 1 pair of non-skid work shoes/boots
- 1 Plain long black or checkered chef pants
- School supplied laptop

Board of Health Regulations During Shop Time

- No nail polish or fake nails
- No beards or sideburns
- No piercings (nose, lip, eyebrow, etc.)
- No earrings

Clothing Requirements

Students are required to wear a clean uniform each day during class time. We will be supplying your child daily with a chef’s jacket, apron, and a side towel for full participation in any culinary/baking class. Safety concerns require that during class each student wears a pair of **long black or checkered chef pants, non-skid footwear with socks as well as the chef's hat which will be given to each student.** Chef pants must not have any holes, rips, or frays. Each student will be assigned a locker in the kitchen to keep their chef pants, shoes, and chef hat.

Footwear

In the interest of safety, all culinary/baking students must wear appropriate kitchen footwear. Appropriate footwear consists of a sturdy black shoe with a non-skid sole. The footwear should encase the foot; students must wear this non-skid footwear daily as part of the uniform.
